Supported Independent Living (SIL)

Supported Independent Living (SIL) is help with and/or supervising daily tasks in a shared living environment, focusing on developing each individual's skills to live as independently as possible. The support provided to each person living in the shared arrangement is based on their support needs.

Assistance provided to a participant is included as part of their plan depending on the level of support they require to live independently in the housing option of their choice.

Individual Living Options (ILO)

These support items introduce new options and alternative ways of living for people with a disability. Individualised Living Options (ILOs) are packages of support built considering each individual's preferences, strengths, assets, support requirements, informal and community supports. An Individualised Living Option is not determined by the homeownership or leasing situation or eligibility for Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) funding. An Individualised Living Option is the support provided and not the accommodation or dwelling itself.

Short-Term Accommodation (STA) & Assistance

These items support self-care, accommodation, food and activities in a centre or group residence for short periods, typically of up to 14 days at a time. They may also include a period of respite, which aims to support ongoing caring arrangements between participants and their carers by allowing their carer short-term breaks from their usual caring responsibilities. The support items cover expenses in a 24-hour period, including assistance with self-care, accommodation, food and negotiated activities. These support items are applied to Getaway Camps.

Medium-Term Accommodation (MTA)

Medium-Term Accommodation (MTA) covers the accommodation costs of this support, with the care component claimed separately. Typically, MTA is used for periods up to 90 days and in conjunction with support services.

This support item recognises that there may be cases where a participant will require longer-term transitional accommodation before moving into a more permanent home or arrangement (for example, after hospital discharge).

In-Home Support (IHS)

Self-Care Activities items provide a participant with assistance with, or supervision of, personal tasks of daily life to develop the participant's skills to live as autonomously as possible.

LiveAbility examples

- Public Transport skills building i.e., 6 sessions of 3 hours each
- Fitness for recreation and health i.e., attend weekly gym together, regular walks and exercise.
- Shopping for fun and skills building – money management, budget planning, decision making.
- Medical appointments - travel logistics, emotional support, note taking, follow-up.
- Accessing your social network to help to meet up with existing friends or make new ones.
- Hobbies and special interest facilitation.
- Baking and cooking for fun and skills-building.
- Volunteering access – support your interest in participating in volunteering programs or activities i.e., zoo, animal shelters.
- Entertainment – support to attend events, shows, special events and other recreation activities.
- Accessing the arts – support to be part of a local theatre group, attend rehearsals.
- Work –coaching, help at work or assistance with your own business, i.e., attendance at markets with you to sell your products, job task breakdown.
- Education or study support - to assist with courses (like WEA) and qualifications working towards skills and knowledge building in their area of interest to achieve potential successful completion. This is suitable for school students and post-school leavers who want to learn new skills.
- Non-face-to-face support – supporting you to plan activities, write reports etc.

Social and Community Support Group Based

These support lines are used for DLI's ExploreAbility and SociAbility Programs. Group based face-to-face supports price per unit is the individual rate divided equally by the number of participants. Non-face-to-face supports and centre capital costs are charged individually.

Capacity Building

These are capacity building support services. The supports in this category allow participants to take part in skills-based learning to develop independence in accessing the community, or improved relationships and improved daily living. They are available as flexible supports designed to suit the client i.e. client identifies the number of hours and the support focus or predefined solution 'packages'.

Examples of use

Capacity building in relation to life transition, mentoring, peers support and individual skills development are delivered through DLI's LiveAbility program.

For example, mentoring and support to investigate options post-school, organise meetings with providers such as employment support providers, visiting places that offer daytime activities, and exploring housing options. Retirement planning support includes accessing resources and information, meeting with peers, options to expand social networking opportunities and facilitating introductions to activities.

Specialist Behaviour Support and Therapy Services

The provision of behaviour supports plans requires specialised assessment where a client may have complex or unclear needs, requiring long term or intensive support to address behaviours of concern. Behaviour support requires a behaviour support plan to be developed that aims to limit the likelihood of behaviours of concern developing or increasing once identified. The plan outlines the specifically designed positive behavioural strategies for a participant, their family and support persons that will achieve the intended outcome of eliminating or reducing behaviours of concern. Therapy supports facilitate functional improvement or to maintain a level of function. Therapy is aimed at adjustment, adaption and building capacity for community participation. Billable activities include assessment, planning and delivery. These supports include face-to-face, non-face-to-face Support Provisions, NDIS Requested Reports and Provider Travel time and travel cost. Therapy supports are available to participants aged 7 and over.

Transport

Transport is charged at three different pricing levels based on the vehicle type. Standard vehicles or support worker vehicles can transport up to 3 clients. Large Passenger Vehicles can usually accommodate 4-7 passengers, whereas Accessible Vehicles and Buses can vary based on accessibility features and requirements.

Transport for group programs will be billed at the applicable shared ratio.

Establishment Fees

This fee applies to all new NDIS participants who receive at least 20 hours of personal care/community access support per month for at least 3 consecutive months.

This payment is to cover non-ongoing costs for providers establishing arrangements and assisting participants in implementing their plans. The establishment fee is claimable by the provider who assists the participant with implementing their NDIS Plan, delivers a minimum of 20 hours per month of personal care/community access support, and has agreed with the participant to supply these services.

Cancellation Fees

Where services are cancelled at short notice or a client is a no show, DLI will charge 100% of the agreed fee associated with the services booked (subject to the NDIS short notice cancellation rules).

Services that are cancelled by the client (or their representative) with sufficient notice will not be charged a fee.

If your service agreement has a shorter notice period than defined in the current NDIS Pricing Arrangements and Price Limits, DLI will apply the shorter cancellation rule until you are transitioned to an updated Service Agreement
